

NO MATTER WHAT YOUR PATH, SUMMER SEARCH HAS YOUR BACK.

This year, one moment that stays with me is the energy and story of a young person who shared her learnings from her summer experience at the Delaware Water Gap. A self-proclaimed "quiet" young person, she spoke about how she leaned into the discomfort of building new relationships, and the excitement she felt about continuing to try new experiences in the future. In that moment, I saw the heart of Summer Search's mission at work—young people stepping into their power, supported by caring adults and transformative opportunities.

In 2025, Summer Search Philadelphia celebrated several important milestones. We launched a Career Coaching Program for our alumni, expanded into three new schools, and launched an innovative in-house summer experience for our young people to explore the plentiful resources right here in Philadelphia. These changes helped us reach more students and better meet their evolving needs.

Looking ahead, we are focused on expanding student enrollment and summer experiences and deepening our connection with our community, ensuring that every Summer Searcher in the Greater Philadelphia area receives the highest quality services. These priorities are rooted in our vision of a world where all young people—regardless of background—can access the resources, relationships and opportunities they deserve.

To our students and families—thank you for your trust, strength and partnership. To our mentors, staff, volunteers, and alumni—you embody the spirit of Summer Search every day. And to our donors, partners, and champions—your belief in our mission makes this work possible.





Mentoring

At the heart of Summer Search's model is Depth Mentoring. Throughout the school year, students meet weekly with their mentors - alternating between one-on-one coaching and dynamic peer group sessions that inspire growth, confidence, and community.

This year, Summer Search doubled down on learning and growth—enhancing program excellence through more mentor observations.

Key findings included:

- Students have high levels of comfort, trust, and emotional presence.
- Mentors are excellent at creating safe, engaging, and supportive spaces especially when guiding tough conversations,
- Continuing to focus on open-ended questioning, deeper follow-up, and personalized engagement will result in even deeper impact.



Post-Secondary Programs

In 2025, we provided 20 high school seniors and 36 PS1 students with regular mentoring touchpoints and targeted supports.

Our Transition Program was delivered via monthly 1:1 and group mentoring sessions, where dedicated post-secondary mentors guided participants through conversations and topics around campus culture, financial literacy, and career exploration.

We also offered college panels for high school junior and seniors featuring our Summer Search postsecondary stars.

Seniors participated in a Paying for College workshop in January and received 1:1 support with financial aid and scholarship applications.

To supercharge our college access services, Summer Search is now partnering with Let's Get Ready, a nationally recognized organization that matches students with trained coaches who provide personalized, text-based guidance throughout the college application process.

Career Services

This year, Summer Search continued to offer individualized career support to Summer Search students and alumni.

Additionally, we worked with our partner Aon to further integrate Summer Search's mentoring model into their Department of Labor-award winning apprenticeship program.

This program, which began in Philadelphia and now includes 170 participants nationwide.



Currently, three Philadelphia Summer Searchers are enrolled, with plans for expansion and replication across industries in the future. The goal is to offer alternative postsecondary opportunities beyond traditional college paths.

Next with Our Career Programming

Summer Search is launching new career readiness supports that are fully integrated into our existing high school and post-secondary programming in the 2025-2026 school year. Leveraging our expertise in mentorship and experiential learning, our strategy includes:


- Early exposure to new career opportunities,
- Building career **experience** through internships, apprenticeships, and fellowships
- Developing professional networks and career mentors.
